



STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE TO LOG IN TO MINT

The following steps will allow you to connect to Mint as Scott, a fictional user you will follow through Mint activities. This setup should take only 5 minutes and you will only do this series of steps the first time you log on to Mint.

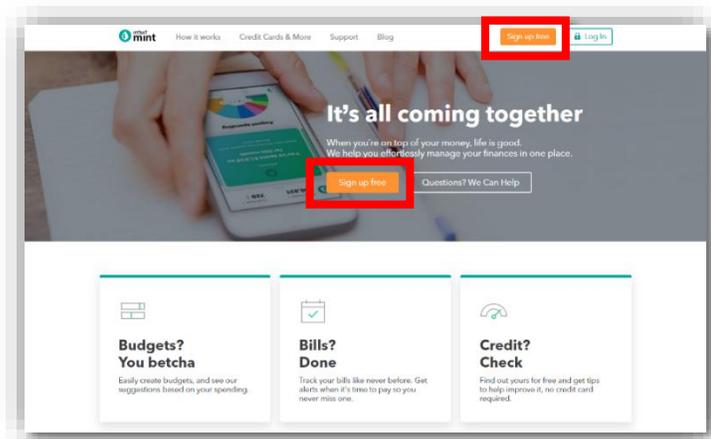


Step 1 is to sign into Mint. *You'll use made-up email address ending in @intuiteducation.com*

Step 2 is to connect to Scott's bank accounts.

Step 3 is to connect to Scott's credit history.

STEP 1: SIGN IN TO MINT



Go to www.Mint.com and click

Sign up Free

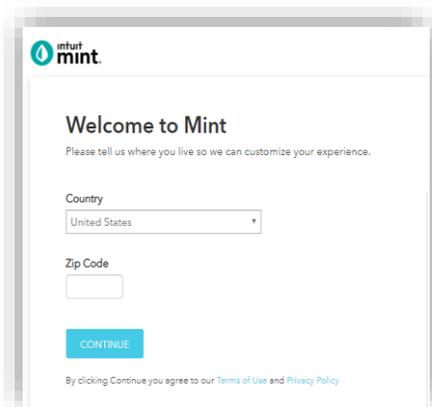
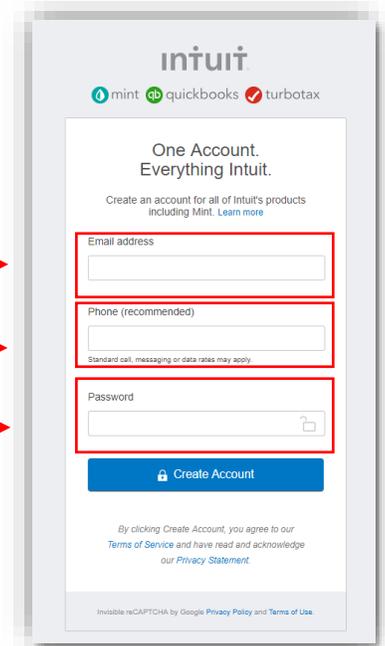
Create any 'fake' email address, but it **must end in**

Example: *MyNameIsJoe@intuiteducation.com*

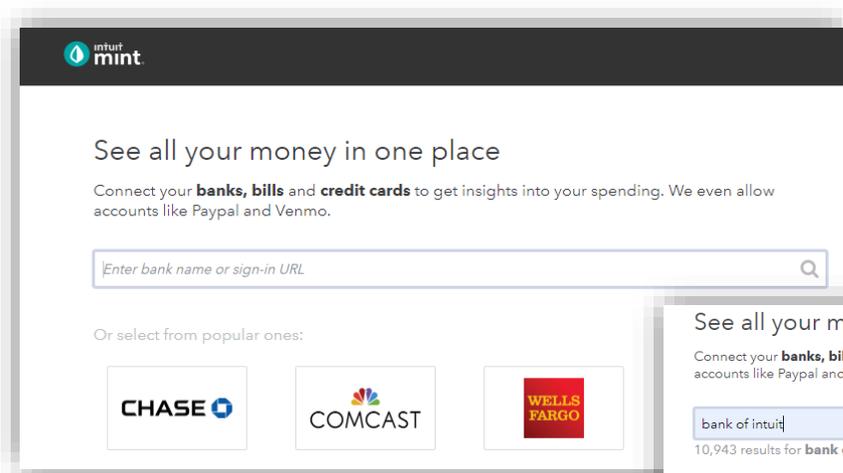
Do not add a phone number

Enter the **zip code** of your school

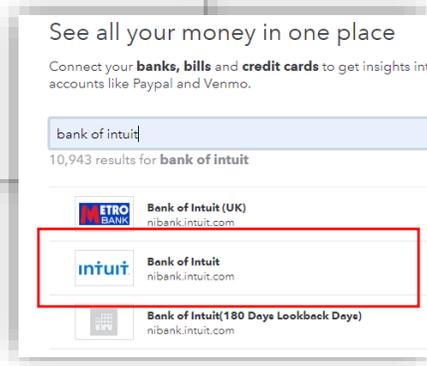
STEP 2: CONNECT TO SCOTT'S BANK ACCOUNTS



Real Mint users connect all their bank accounts, bills, credit cards, one at a time.

For this simulation we do a one-time upload of all data.

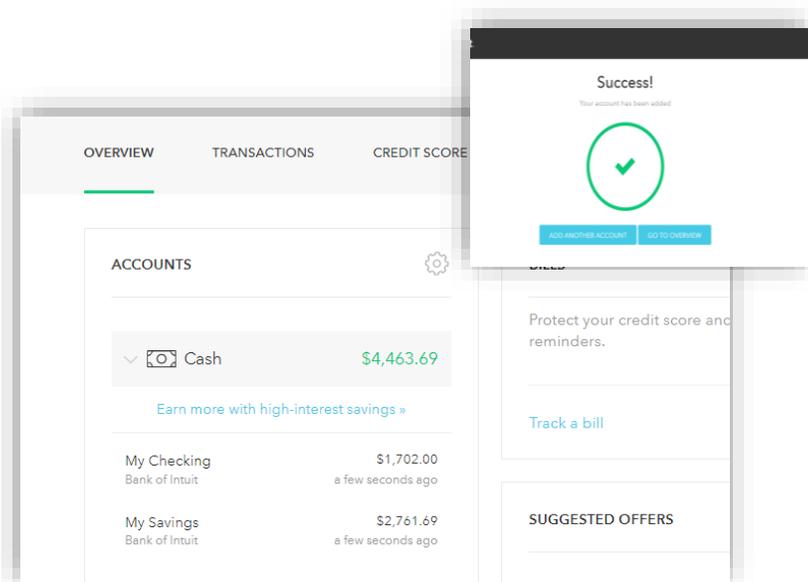
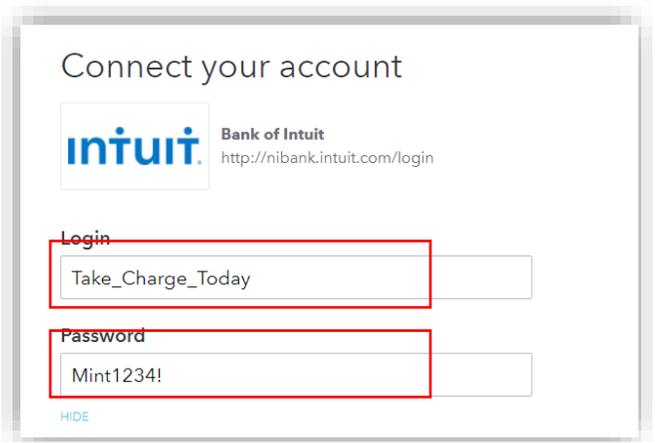
Search for **Bank of Intuit**



When prompted, connect to Bank of Intuit with the following information:

Password: Mint1234!



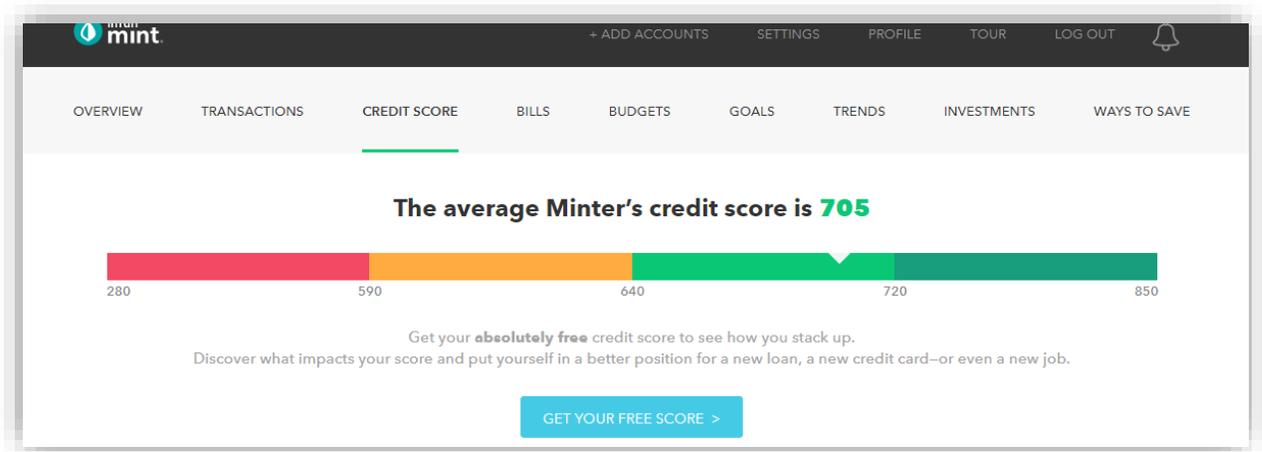

STEP 3: CONNECT TO SCOTT'S CREDIT SCORE

First, from the dashboard, click on Credit Score tab. Then press the **Get Your Free Score** button.
