



Feature	Description	Benefit
Local Processing	Operates entirely on local hardware without cloud dependency.	Ensures data privacy and security by keeping information on-device, preventing external access.
No Data Sharing	No transmission to external servers.	Protects user confidentiality by avoiding information sharing with third-party systems.
Reduced Latency	No need for internet connectivity.	Provides fast and responsive interactions, beneficial in time-sensitive applications.






Prompting

FORMAT: What is the specific output?

VOICE: What style of language is desired?


- Using academic/marketing/comic/medical language, right-wing/left-wing, modern/archaic

- Like a copywriter, engineer, human resources manager, millennial, politician,
- In the style of my professor, Oprah, this historical/anthropological person/group
- Respond as if you were Yoda, Martin Luther King Jr, single/married, happy/sad
- Include tone modifiers: serious & empathetic, casual & funny, or positive & enthusiastic

- Suitable as a reading assignment for an undergraduate course

- Summarize Each Chapter:
- Write a one-sentence summary for each chapter in this book.
- List and Sort Characters:
- Make a list of all the characters in the story and sort them by how much they talk and how much attention they get.
- Plan Events and Tasks:
- Look at the events planned for the next six months and make a list of tasks for each one. Ask how long each task will take and see if there's enough time between events to prepare.
- Turn Story into Screenplay:
- List all the locations in the story and sort them by how much time is spent in each place.

Enhancing Communication & Inclusivity Communication

- Clarify Instructions Identify any unclear or confusing parts.
- Compassionate Tone Make emails friendlier and more supportive.
- **Inspirational Stories** Find motivating stories for college students.





- Skills Section Highlight core strengths and capabilities.
- Action Words Use impactful verbs for job experience.
- Professional Structure Polish format and layout.

Interviewing

- Ask Open-Ended Questions: Invite the person to share something meaningful about their values, projects, or life.
- Practice Active Listening: Listen with the intention of truly understanding their perspective.
- Engage with Follow-Up Questions:
 Dive deeper by asking follow-up
 questions to uncover more about their
 values and motivations.
- Define the Desired Emotional Impact: Think about the emotional response you want to evoke.
- Make a Prediction and Seek Feedback:
 Before sharing your tribute or essay,
 predict the response you'll receive, then share it to get actual feedback.

Formulating Multiple-Choice Questions:

• For each multiple-choice question, include one correct answer and four other options that seem believable but are wrong. Avoid using "none of the above" or "all of the above" as answer choices.

Role playing

- Scenario: You are a busy venture capitalist (like Mark Cuban on Shark Tank), and I am an entrepreneur looking for funding.
- Task: Ask me to present my pitch and then ask questions about my business idea.
- Scenario: Pretend you are a client who needs help with statistical analysis of a customer survey data set.
- Task: Ask me questions that you would need answers to as your analyst.




AI as tutor

- **2. Simplified Explanation**: Can you break this down into simpler terms?
- 3. Illustrative Scenarios and Examples: Could you explain this passage or concept by creating scenarios and examples that demonstrate it in action?
- 4. Feedback on Midterm Response:
 Here's my answer to question Y on the midterm. Could you help me understand what might be incorrect about it?
- 5. Job-Related Real-World Examples: Could you provide an example of how I might apply this in a career in technology, sports, politics, or economics?

- Provide examples of how X relates to your own experience..





In-the-Moment Journaling

- Relating Concepts to Personal Experiences: How can these concepts connect to your own experiences?
