Answers will vary. However, some specific content should be included:

- Personal vs. Private. Private information is risky to share: full name, address, telephone number, age, birthday, or school. However, sharing personal likes and dislikes is less risky.
- Cyberstrangers: Someone could pretend to be someone else online. You don't know the identity of someone contacting you online.
- Never agree to meet with someone you met online.
- Other content about specific items may be included.
